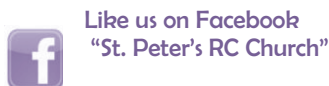

Dear Parishioners,

As you are well aware, our Parish of St. Peter the Apostle has quite a history. A fascinating history provides an array of equally fascinating characters. None more so than the Irish immigrant priest, the Rev. James D. Power.

Last August, I did my annual retreat at the Benedictine's Conception Abbey in northwest Missouri. My journey there didn't start from the airport in Philadelphia but in the archives of our parish.

When I first arrived as your pastor in 2005, I spent some time poking through this treasure trove. I came upon a reference to a Father Power from St. Peter Church in Reading who, in 1858, during an economic depression, accompanied several Irish west to the frontier to see if they could improve their luck. I was impressed by this pioneer priest but never did any further research.

And then in May of 2014 a certain Frank O'Reilly--who has several family connections with our parish and with whom I have had previous contact--had sent me a book entitled *A History of Conception. Colony, Abbey and Schools* by Edward E. Malone, O.S.B. One of Mr. O'Reilly's forebears helped form an association to investigate the possibility of establishing an Irish Catholic colony in the west.

Malone dedicates a section in his book to the Reading Land Association. The U.S. government was looking to settle the territory west of the Mississippi River and the land association was established to aid adventurous Irish to do just that. Father Power plays a prominent role in this adventure.

So now, having had my passing interested quickened by what I read in this scholarly work, I decided to do my annual retreat in Conception. My focus was spiritual, of course, but I would take some time to see if I could uncover some more information on Father Power. It didn't take me long.

At supper the first night, I inquired of one of the brothers if he had ever heard of Father Power. "Sure," was the reply, "he is buried across the street in the parish cemetery." The abbot, who I ran into in the cemetery after having found the grave, informed me that research done by another priest was the basis for much of the information in *A History of Conception*.

What I discovered was that not only did this former pastor of our St. Peter Parish provide wise guidance during the formation of the land association, travel west as part of the investigation committee and spiritually shepherd the seventeen pioneers in what is now northwest Missouri, but he was also the one who named the colony! The dogma of the Immaculate Conception was defined only a few years earlier (1854) so it is no surprise that he suggested the colony be named Conception. He later invited the Benedictines into the village to establish a school which developed into the present abbey and seminary.

Father Power apparently was well known and respected in those parts. Upon his death in 1899 at age of 84, his body lay in state in the diocesan cathedral so influential was this man who once pastored our parish.

On my last night in Conception, I placed between the headstone and the base of Father Power's grave, a letter I wrote to him. That letter will be published in April 2nd's bulletin.

Estimados Feligreses,

Como bien saben, nuestra iglesia de San Pedro el Apóstol tiene bastante historia. Una historia fascinante ofreciendo una serie de personajes igualmente fascinantes. Nada más que el sacerdote inmigrante de Irlanda, Rev. James D. Power.

El pasado agosto, hice mi retiro anual en Benedictine's Conception Abbey, en el noroeste de Missouri. Mi viaje no empezó desde el aeropuerto de Filadelfia, sino en los archivos de nuestra parroquia.

Cuando llegué por primera vez como su pastor en 2005, pasé un tiempo explorando este tesoro. Me encontré con una referencia a un Padre Power de la Iglesia de San Pedro en Reading que, en 1858, durante una depresión económica, acompañó a varios irlandeses del oeste a la frontera para ver si podían mejorar su suerte. Me impresionó este sacerdote pionero, pero nunca hice más investigaciones.

Y luego en mayo de 2014 un cierto Frank O'Reilly -- Quien tiene varias conexiones familiares con nuestra parroquia y con quien he tenido contacto previo --Me había enviado un libro titulado, *A History of Conception. Colony, Abbey and Schools* by Edward E. Malone, O.S.B. Uno de los antepasados de O'Reilly ayudó a formar una asociación para investigar la posibilidad de establecer una colonia católica irlandesa en el oeste.

Malone dedica una sección en su libro a Reading Land Association. El gobierno de los estados unidos estaba mirando para colocar el territorio al oeste del río de Mississippi y la asociación de la tierra fue establecida para ayudar a irlandeses aventureros hacer apenas eso. Padre Power juega un papel prominente en esta aventura.

Así que ahora, habiendo acelerado mi paso por lo que leí en este trabajo académico, decidí hacer mi retiro anual en Conception. Mi enfoque era espiritual, por supuesto, pero tomaría algún tiempo para ver si podría descubrir más información sobre Padre Power. No me tomó mucho tiempo.

En la cena de la primera noche, le pregunté a uno de los hermanos si alguna vez había oído hablar del Padre Power "Claro", fue la respuesta, está enterrado al otro lado de la calle en el cementerio parroquial. El abad, al que me encontré en el cementerio después de haber encontrado la tumba, me informó que la investigación realizada por otro sacerdote era la base de gran parte de la información de *A History of Conception*.

Lo que descubrí fue que no sólo este ex pastor de nuestra parroquia de San Pedro proporcionó una sabia guía durante la formación de la asociación de la tierra, viajó al oeste como parte del comité de investigación y pastoreó espiritualmente a los diecisiete pioneros en lo que ahora es el noroeste de Missouri; Él también fue el que nombró a la colonia! The dogma of the Immaculate Conception, se definió sólo unos pocos años antes (1854), por lo cual no es ninguna sorpresa que sugirió que la colonia se nombrara Conception. Más tarde invitó a los benedictinos al pueblo para establecer una escuela que se convirtió en la actual abbey and seminary.

El Padre Power aparentemente era bien conocido y respetado en esas partes. Sobre su muerte en 1899 en la edad de 84, su cuerpo estaba en estado en la catedral diocesana tan influyente era este hombre que una vez pastoreó nuestra parroquia.

En mi última noche en Concepción, puse entre la lápida y la base de la tumba del Padre Potente, una carta que le escribí. Dicha carta se publicará en el boletín del 2 de Abril.

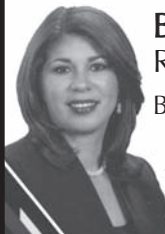
