Baptism: First Sunday of the month (English); second and fourth Sundays of the month (Spanish). Attendance at a Baptism Workshop is mandatory for both parents and godparents prior to the sacrament. At least one godparent must be a fully initiated Catholic, age sixteen or older and, if a member of another parish, must present a certificate of sponsorship.

Thoughts of the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

I sat in the confessional at SS Cyril and Methodius church a few Sundays ago awaiting the next penitent. I picked up the black and well-worn copy of a 19th century work on confession that has been lying on the seat upon which I sat. I suppose it had been there for quite some time.

I noticed "Rev. Michael Lesko" was written in pencil on the inside cover. The penmanship was that of Palmer. I found the Latin words *Ex Libris Pauli J. Lisicky*--written with a fountain pen--on the title page. The connections between my hometown of Lansford and SS Cyril and Methodius trace back to about 1905.

Father Lisicky served as an assistant pastor to the Slovaks who worshipped in their church at 6th and Laurel Streets. His short stay in the middle of the first decade of the last century was followed by one or two other short assignments before being named pastor of St. Michael Slovak Catholic Parish in my hometown. That pastorate lasted until 1955, well over forty years. I never met him, but I heard plenty of stories about "PJ."

Father Lesko, a son of St. Michael, served in SS Cyril and Methodius from 1963 to 1981. The statue between the church and rectory was erected in his memory.

As luck would have it--or divine providence--the bishop named yet another Lansfordian to succeed Father Lesko. That was Father Vincent York, current pastor of St Elizabeth of Hungary in Pen Argyl.

The connections continue. Father Kozak's home parish of SS Peter and Paul Polish Catholic was located in my hometown. In fact, directly across Abbott Street from my home where my Mom and Dad still live.

So, as I sit in the confessional of SS Cyril and Methodius church, pray at its altar and greet the wonderful families after Mass, I can never forget the beautiful connections between my hometown and the faith community on South 6th Street in the town that I have called home for more than twenty years now.

Pensamientos del Pastor

Estimados Feligreses,

Me senté en el confesionario en la iglesia SS Cyril & Methodius unos pocos domingos atrás esperando al siguiente penitente. Recogí la copia negra y bien gastada de una obra del siglo 19° sobre la confesión que ha estado acostada en el asiento en el que estaba sentado. Supongo que había estado allí por bastante tiempo.

Me di cuenta de que "Rev. Michael Lesko" estaba escrito a lápiz en la cubierta interior. La caligrafía era la de Palmer. Encontré las palabras en latín *Ex Libris Pauli J. Lisicky* - escritas con una pluma estilográfica - en la portada. Las conexiones entre mi pueblo natal de Lansford y SS Cyril & Methodius se rastrea aproximadamente al 1905.

El padre Lisicky sirvió como pastor asistente de los eslovacos que adoraban en su iglesia en las calles 6 y Laurel. Su corta estancia en el medio de la primera década del siglo pasado fue seguida por una o dos otras asignaciones cortas antes de ser nombrado párroco de la parroquia católica eslovaca de St. Michael en mi pueblo natal. Ese pastorado duró hasta 1955, más de cuarenta años. Nunca lo conocí, pero oí muchas historias sobre "PJ."

El padre Lesko, hijo de St. Michael, sirvió en SS Cyril & Methodius de 1963 a 1981. La estatua entre la iglesia y la rectoría fue erigida en su memoria.

Como la suerte lo tendría--o providencia divina--el obispo nombró a otro Lansfordiano para suceder al Padre Lesko. Ese era el Padre Vincent York, párroco actual de Santa Elizabeth of Hungary en Pen Argyl.

Las conexiones continúan. La parroquia de origen del Padre Kozak de SS Peter & Paul Polish Catholic estaba ubicada en Lansford. De hecho, en la calle Abbott propio frente de la casa donde mi mamá y papá todavía viven.

Por lo tanto, mientras me siento en el confesionario de la iglesia SS Cyril & Methodius, rezo en su altar y saludo a las familias después de la Misa, nunca podré olvidar las hermosas conexiones entre mi pueblo natal y la comunidad de fe en la calle sur de la 6 en la ciudad que he llamado casa hace más de veinte años.

SACRAMENTAL / SPIRITUAL LIFE

PARISH REGISTRATION: To all new parishioners: Welcome! Our parish is a family and we want to know you personally by name and invite you to share your responsibility as members of St. Peter the Apostle Parish. To register as a member, contact someone on the pastoral staff. One of the priests will be available to register you on the second and fourth weekends-Saturday and Sunday--after all Masses in Marciano Hall. For other times please call the rectory (610-372-9652) to arrange a face-to-face meeting. We are eager to meet you!



BAPTISMS: Celebrated the *first* and *second Sundays* of the month *after* the 12:30 p. m. Mass and the *fourth Sunday* of the month *during* the 12:30 p. m. Mass. Please call Sr. Margaret to arrange for an appointment before attending the Baptism workshop. The godparents must be practicing Catholics that attend Mass and give a good example to their godchild. They must be fully initiated, that is to have received the Sacraments of Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation. The godparents can be single, but if they are married, they must be married in the Catholic Church. Children who are first grade and older must attend Religious Education classes to prepare for baptism.

HOLY MATRIMONY: Couples that wish to marry must contact the Parish House immediately after engagement to arrange for the necessary preparation. Couples in a civil marriage must receive the Sacrament of Marriage by the Church in order to receive Communion again. For this, contact any of our priests.

HOMEBOUND: Call the Parish House to arrange visitations. Visitations are made by Eucharistic ministers weekly. Visitations are made once a month by the priests around on the first Friday of the month.



ANOIDTING OF THE SICK: It's a sacrament that should be received not only by any catholic who is near death, but also by any that is seriously ill or weak from old age. For more information call the Parish House.

QUINCEAÑERA: There is *only one* monthly celebration for all the young women who want to celebrate a Quinceañeras in our parish in a particular month. The date is *generally* the third Saturday of the month (at 1:00p.m.) and always determined by the parish. 
